GLIMPSES FROM THE FUTURE: Art from the Lunar Library

Through September 6, 2010

In the W.W.Browning Gallery (Mezzanine Level)

The Museum presents a fascinating art exhibition from the Lunar Library (www.outofthecradle.net/categories/lunar-library)—an internet reference source about the Moon and other aspects of the high frontier. The web site catalogues a physical collection of over 2,000 items including books, art, DVDs, maps, pop culture items such as toys and games, *selenospheres* (Moon globes), and even foodstuffs such as Moon soup.

The exhibition—at once scientific, serious and whimsical—is divided into four sections that reflect the themes of Lunar imagery, traveling to the Moon, working on the Moon, and Lunar family experiences.

The Lunar Library site is housed at the Out of the Cradle website, www.OutoftheCradle.net. Both are maintained by Ken Murphy of Addison, Texas, a commercial space development advocate and Master of Space Studies graduate *cum laude* from the International Space University in Strasbourg, France. He was a U.S. delegate to the Space Generation Forum at the 1999 United Nations' UNISPACE III Conference in Vienna, and was also co-chair of the 2007 International Space Development Conference in Dallas, Texas. As a member of the National Space Society of North Texas since 2003, and having also served as its President, Murphy directs the Society's collaboration with the Frontiers of Flight Museum as the content and program coordinator for the Museum's annual Moon Day celebration.
