

# DIY SEED BOMBS!

Its guerilla warfare for plants! You can use them on your own yard or to even beautify an abandoned area.



## Materials needed:

- Kiln-dry clay
- Organic potting soil
- Perennial flower seed, preferably TX natives
- Mixing bowl

## Directions:

1. Mix clay and potting soil half and half.
2. Mix until smooth; it should feel like a gooey brownie!
3. Use enough mix to make a ball about 1" in diameter.
4. Put 3 to 4 seeds in each ball and fold until they are in the middle.
5. Set aside to dry for a few days.
6. After they've dried, take on the mission and toss them into an area you want to have wild flowers.
7. Either water or wait for rain to dissolve the clay and potting soil. This will give the seeds a place to start growing.
