



Frontiers of Flight Museum

Field Trip Guidelines

GENERAL INFORMATION

- At least one adult chaperone is recommended for every ten students and one for every five students under the age 5.
- Teachers and other adult chaperones are responsible for student conduct; chaperones must always stay with their groups.
- All groups must always be respectful of other Museum visitors.
- Students should not run, make excessive noise, or cross barriers. They should not touch any of the artifacts unless specifically invited to do so by Museum personnel.
- Students should leave any bags or large personal items on the bus.
- Students are welcome to visit the Museum Store in their groups with their chaperones.
- Kindergarten and younger are welcome to enjoy the Museum's Children's Area if the group has the recommended chaperone count. Limited to smaller groups (50 or less) with a maximum of ten students in the area at a time. Students must be closely monitored, or they may be asked to leave.

GUIDED & SELF-GUIDED TOURS

- Guided tour groups will be split into smaller units. Units must stay together during their tour. Guided tours are subject to availability of our docents and are not guaranteed.
- Self-guided tour groups must always be supervised by an adult. Copies of the Museum scavenger hunts are available at the front desk. Writing utensils are not provided.

LUNCHES

- Food and drinks are only allowed in the Museum's designated eating areas: the Coca-Cola® Café, Hutchison Family Birthday Party Hangar, and outside.
- Groups larger than 70 will need to stagger their lunch times to utilize the spaces.

EDUCATIONAL PROGRAMS

- Groups scheduled to attend an education and/or planetarium program should have students split up according to the numbers on the invoice. The classrooms and planetarium have limited space and have been divided accordingly.
